Common Council Reorganizational Meeting  
Council Chambers, Public Safety Building

Mayor Jim Griffin presided at a Reorganizational Meeting of the Common Council of the City of Stoughton, Dane County, Wisconsin, held in the Council Chambers, Public Safety Building, on Tuesday, April 21, 2009 at 6:00 o'clock p.m.

City Clerk Alme called the roll and the following Alderpersons were present: Carter, Chenoweth, Christianson, Jenson, Lawrence, McKichan, Odland, Olstad, Scovotti, Swangstu, Tone and Weiss.

Mayor Griffin presented the 2010 Volunteer of the Year award to Evelyn Kahl; 2010 Business Person of the Year award to Kent Schroeder; and the 2010 Friend of Youth Award to Sonny Swangstu.

City Clerk Alme administered the oath of office to Mayor Elect Donna Olson and she was seated as Mayor.

City Clerk Alme administered the oath of office to the following newly elected Alderpersons: Sonny Swangstu, Ronald Christianson, Carl Chenoweth, Eric Olstad and Eric Hohol and they were seated as Alderpersons.

After seating the incoming Alderpersons, City Clerk Alme called the roll and the following Alderpersons were present: Carter, Chenoweth, Christianson, Hohol, Jenson, Lawrence, McKichan, Olstad, Scovotti, Swangstu, Tone and Weiss.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by those in attendance with the American Legion Honor Guard presiding.

Moved by Scovotti, seconded by Jenson, to nominate Alderperson Carter as Council President.

Moved by Swangstu, seconded by Christianson, to nominate Alderperson Tone as Council President.

There being no other nominations, the following vote was taken by voice ballot with Alderperson Carter receiving 9 (nine) votes and Alderperson Tone receiving 3 (three) votes.

Moved by Chenoweth, seconded by Carter, to nominate Alderperson Tone as Council Vice-President. There being no other nominations, motion to nominate Alderperson Tone as Council Vice-President was carried unanimously by acclamation.

Moved by Christianson, seconded by McKichan, to adopt a resolution regarding the local depositories and authorized signatures for the City of Stoughton and Stoughton Utilities, as presented. Motion carried unanimously by acclamation.

Moved by Chenoweth, seconded by Scovotti, to adopt a resolution regarding the designation of official newspapers for the City of Stoughton, as presented. Motion carried unanimously by acclamation.

Moved by Carter, seconded by Lawrence, to confirm the Mayoral appointments to Committees, Boards and Commissions, as presented. Motion carried unanimously by acclamation.

Moved by Lawrence, seconded by Jenson, to adjourn the meeting at 6:16 p.m. Carried unanimously by acclamation.
